The students involved in these combined courses chose to take that course and are currently involved in all aspects required to attain both Developmental and College Algebra credits. The students in these courses, as well as everyone enrolled in this course, are being asked to complete several tasks that include the following.

1. **THEA-IBT (Internet Based Test):** A list of additional test dates, other than the ones I mentioned to you on Wednesday, are as follows.
